Achilles St. Louis Tandem Program Launched

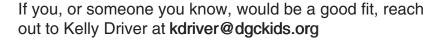
Achilles St. Louis (https://www.achillesinternational.org/st-louis), in partnership with Cycle St. Louis (cyclestl.org), launched an Adult Tandem Program on April 19th with rides taking place every Wednesday evening at 6:00 pm, starting from the Forest Park Visitor Center. Some of the participants haven't ridden since they were children and it's clear this program is having a big impact on the well-being of adults with disabilities. A big thanks to Paraquad for allowing tandem storage in their garage and Delta Gamma Center Tandem Captains for showing up each week. Delta Gamma Center Needs Tandem Captains

Are you an avid cyclist? Do you want to share your love of the sport? Delta Gamma Center, which serves blind and visually impaired children and their families, is searching for additional captains for their Tandem Adventurers cycling team.

Any experience is welcome and you'll receive extensive tandem training so you can ride with incredible DGC kids. Solo riders are also needed to help guide the group. Rides are weekly from April through September and last about two hours (15-20) miles)
